A flooring system is only as good as its bond to the substrate. Complete and total surface preparation is an operation that is crucial to all flooring projects. This takes place before any floor coating material can be applied. The purpose of surface preparation is to open the pores of the concrete and facilitate penetration of the coating materials. In some cases, an existing coating must be removed before a new system can be applied. Special equipment is used to remove this coating while doing minimal damage to the substrate. Benning's surface preparation equipment is designed for maximum dust control. State of the art shot-blasters, scarifiers, and stand-up grinding units enable edging in those hard to reach areas. EQUIPMENT

16" SHOT BLASTER

PURPOSE: Shot blasting abrades the surface, and open the pores of the concrete substrate.



STAND-UP GRINDER

PURPOSE: This unit abrades the concrete surface right up to the walls and large equipment as well as those hard to reach areas



SCARIFIER

PURPOSE: This unit removes existing coatings to expose porous concrete.



6" TRIM SHOT BLASTER

PURPOSE: This shot blaster abrades tight enclosed surfaces too large for grinding, but too small for our large shot blast units.



DUST FREE PULSE VAC

PURPOSE: This specially designed Dust Free Pulse Vac vacuum is attached to all trim equipment and helps to contain the dust.
